CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

*****NEW*** Broadway Babies 1 (12months – 36months)**

Come and join us for an hour class of musical fun! We will learn about musical themes such as tempo, rhythm, and volume in a fun and nurturing environment. The children will learn classic children's songs, use percussion instruments, play, sing, and dance along to many different styles of music. (Parent participation required).

*****NEW*** Broadway Babies 2 (36 months – 48months)**

In this hour-long class students will learn the basics of music including tempo, rhythm, and volume. We will also begin to explore the beginnings of musical theatre including dancing and acting through imagination and pretend. The children will learn classic children's songs as well as use percussion instruments to play, sing, and dance along to many different styles of music. (Parent participation not required)

Broadway Munchkins (4-5yrs)

Introduce your child to the world of musical theatre with acting games, singing and dancing. There will be a simple performance at the end of the session. The Munchkins class runs two sessions, September – January and February – June.

Broadway Mini-Stars – Beginner (5-8yrs)

Introduce your 5-8 yr old to a mini-musical. Students should be showing a readiness to take direction, memorize and recite lines, plus partake in a 30 min show (5 yr. olds that are not at this maturity level are encouraged to register for Munchkins).

Broadway MiniStars Advanced (5-8yrs by recommendation)

A more focused mini-production class for the excelling youngster. Students should be showing a readiness to take direction, memorize and recite lines, and partake in a 60 min show.

Students registered in Broadway MiniStars Advanced are required to take one Lindbjerg dance class.

Broadway Juniors (8-12yrs)

Beginner or intermediate who wants a "fun focused" class. This class teaches the basics of singing, dancing, and acting plus performing in a short musical. We offer three Broadway Junior Classes.

Broadway Youngstars (8-12 yrs. by recommendation)

A more focused class for the experienced young performer who would like to take their skills to the next level. Experience in singing, dancing, and acting required. Strong commitment a must. Potential school performances will require students to miss 2 days of school.

Students registered in Broadway Youngstars are required to take one Lindbjerg dance class.

Broadway Rising Stars (11-16yrs by recommendation)

This class is for the keen youngster ready to perform at the upper level in a full-scale musical. Strong commitment required. Potential school performances will require students to miss 2 days of school. Students may not miss any rehearsals or shows during production week or you may be removed from the show. Maximum 5 missed classes per 10-month period.

Students registered in Broadway Rising Stars are required to take one Lindbjerg dance class.

Broadway Rising Stars Advanced (14-18yrs - by recommendation) (Formerly Young Stars Advanced)

This class is for the keen youngster ready to perform at the upper level in a full scale musical. Audition only class. Must register to hold an audition spot. Strong commitment required. Potential school performances will require students to miss 2 days of school. Students may not miss any rehearsals or shows during production week or you may be removed from the show. Maximum 5 missed classes per 10-month period.

Acting (9 – 12 years)

Come learn and explore the world of acting in the areas of theatre, film, and television. Voice projection, monologues, character development and how to audition are just some areas that will be covered.

Acting (13+)

In this comprehensive acting program, young actors will be given a solid grounding into the world of professional acting. Taught by Top Industry Professionals, this course will include, acting training, {using scenes and monologues from both classic and contemporary plays}, voice and movement classes, music theory, the art of improvisation, film acting, acting for musical theatre and audition skills. We will conclude the program with a classroom showcase performance of chosen scenes and monologues.

*****NEW*** Shakespeare (14+) – “Bard 101”**

Dive into the world of William Shakespeare, one of histories most influential writers. Students will partake in numerous acting exercises that will not only prepare them for performing Shakespeare, but it will also giving them tools they will be able to use for any other play they approach, be it musical or not. The course will end in students performing one of Shakespeare plays, while also giving them the opportunity to learn about other areas of production, from props, costumes, and sets, all the way to tickets and publicity.

*****NEW*** Adult Acting Class**

The perfect class for anyone who has had the desire to “walk the boards” or breakout of their shell and try something new. This class will challenge all levels as we take on character development, scene study, and improv, while having loads of fun. Students are able to work at their own pace.
