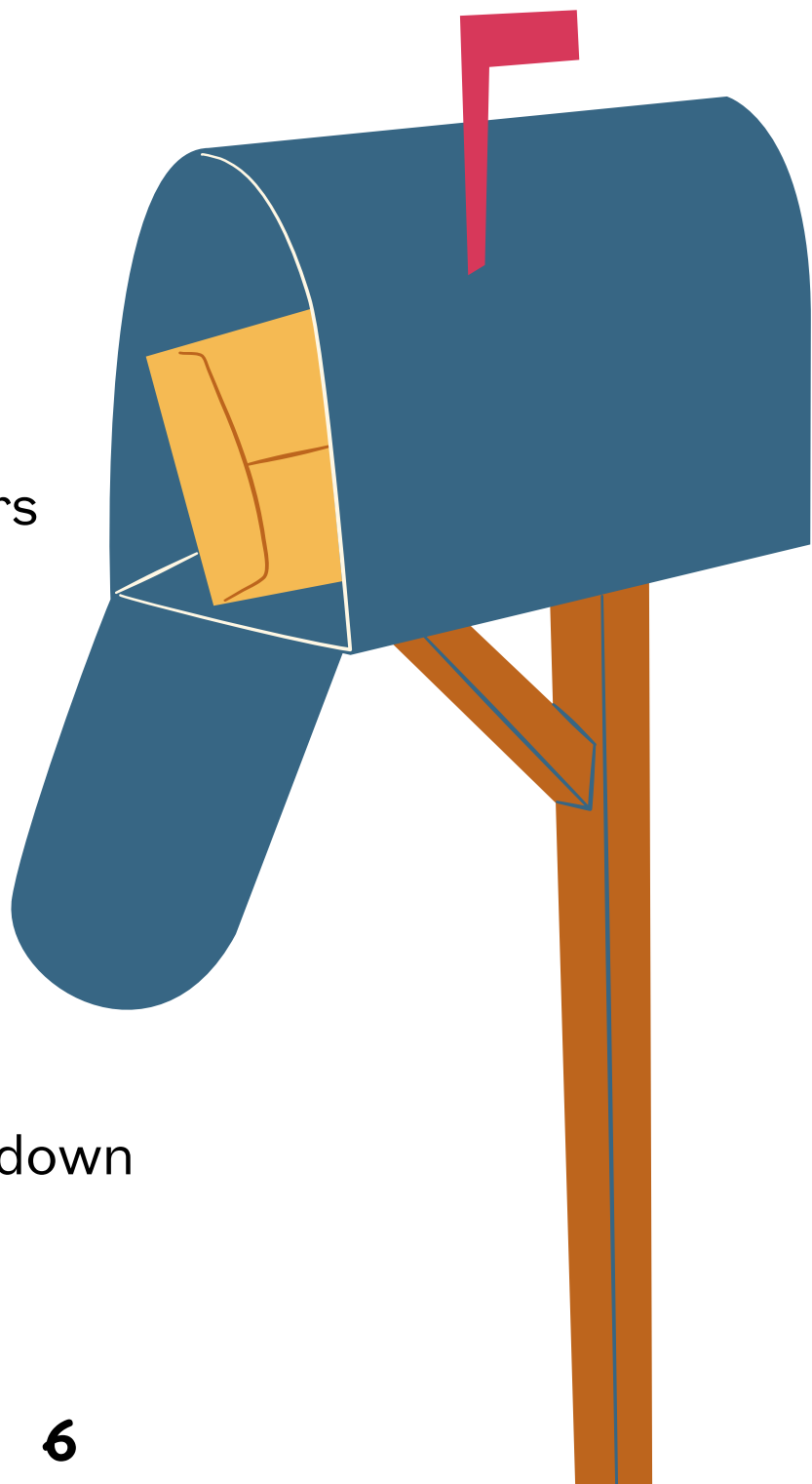

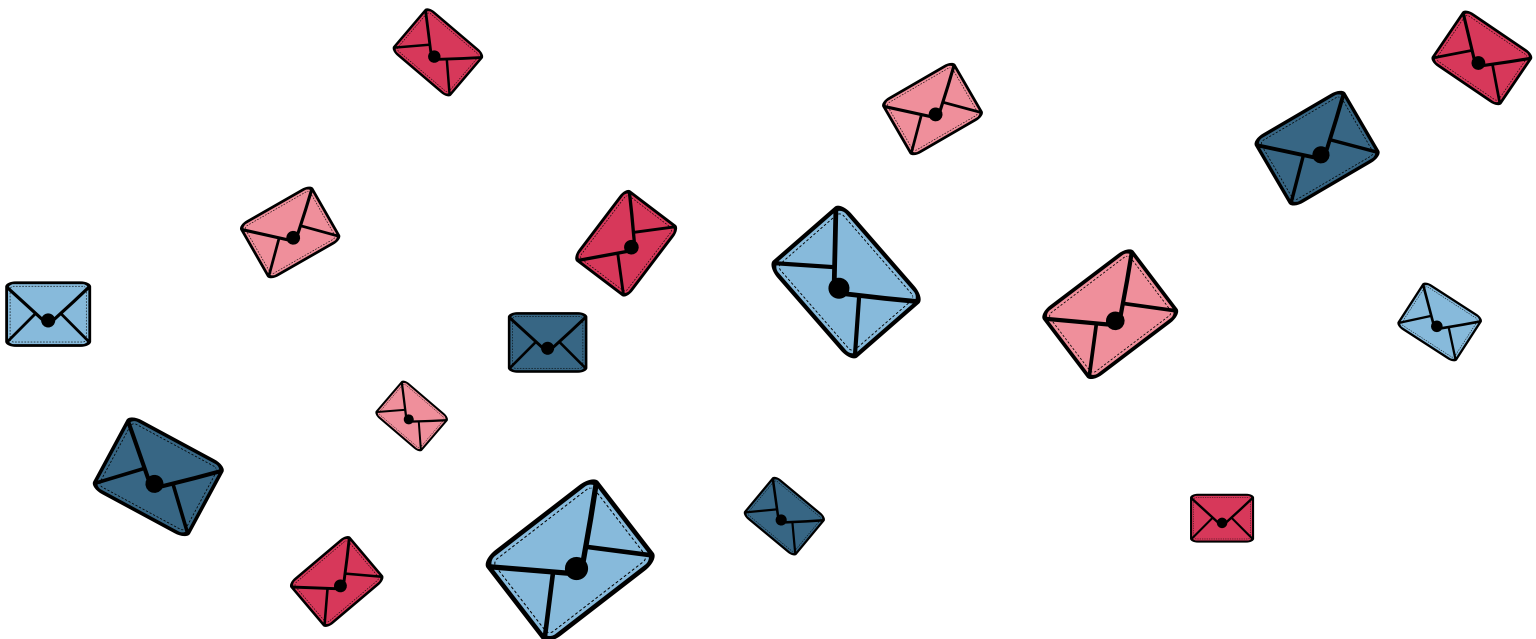
KYLA TURPIN

CHANTELLE WARD Teacher



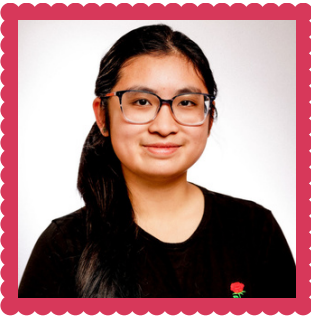

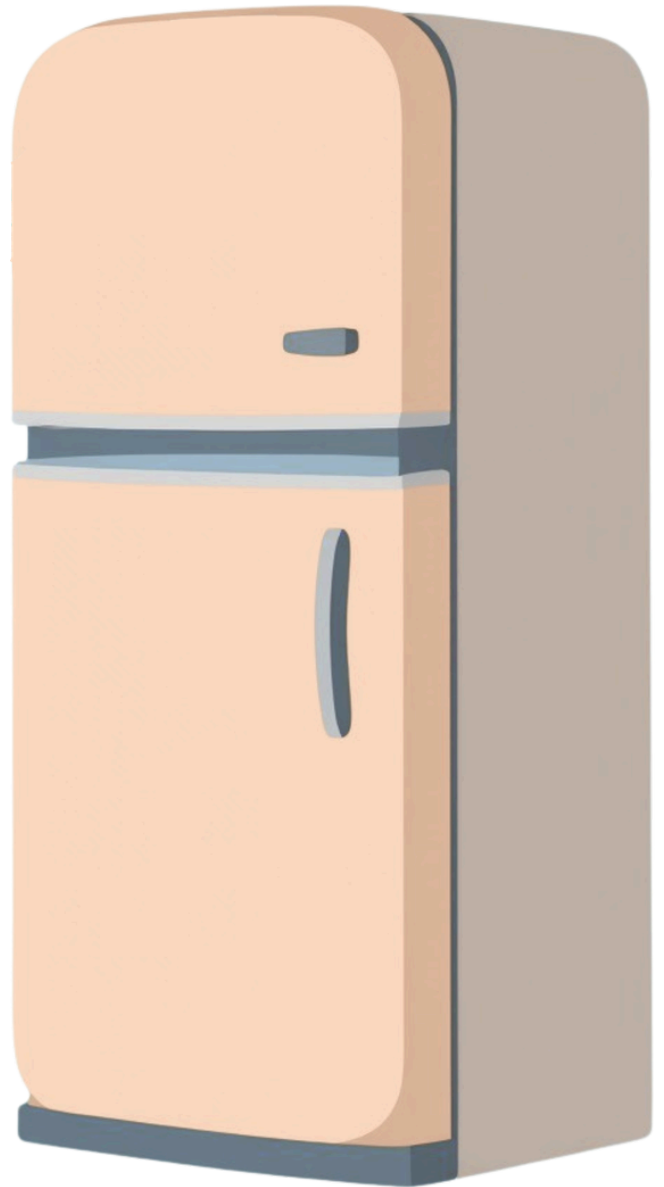
TEACHING TEAM

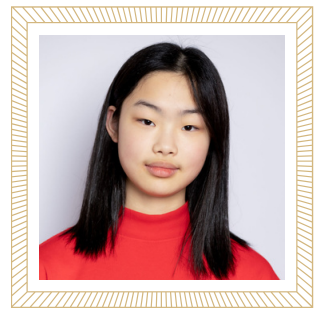

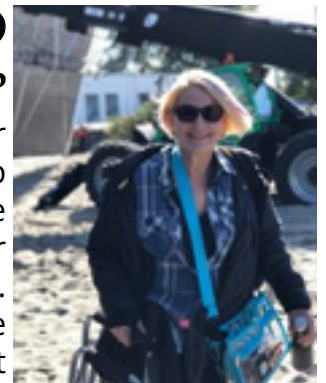


IAN BALLARD WIGS AND MAKEUP

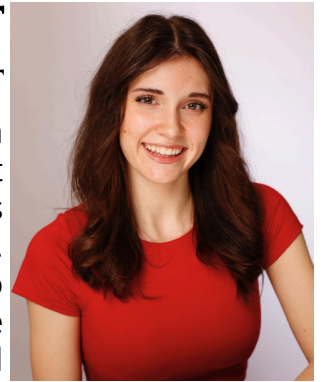
ELISABETH POLLOCK PROPS DEPARTMENT HEAD
